Code of Conduct 2017



The Loreto Nedlands BYOD Code of Conduct is designed to complement the Loreto Nedlands Student ICT Acceptable Use Policy. It aims to support a positive digital learning environment for all users.

Code of Conduct:

- ◆ Arrive at school with a charged device. (The school will NOT provide charging facilities for student owned devices).
- ◆ Students are responsible for the maintenance and care of their own device.
- ◆ Students are responsible for regular data back-ups and software/app updates.
- ◆ Non-educational apps and those not required by the teacher must be placed in a “HOME” folder.
- ◆ Non-educational apps/sites and software are NOT to be accessed during school hours. This includes web2 tools.
- ◆ Devices are only to be used under teacher instruction. Students must remain on task and are not permitted to access other information.
- ◆ Students must NOT interfere with any other person’s device.
- ◆ Students must NOT record or post content of a person (picture/video/information) without permission.
- ◆ If students receive an image that is offensive from an unknown source, students must capture the image. Do NOT delete the evidence. Students must then inform their parent/carer/teacher.
- ◆ Students are permitted to share information and work collaboratively with teacher supervision.

In the circumstance where the Code of Conduct are broken, firm and reasonable action will be taken.
